Did you know?

- Trover offers 55 services and specialties to the people of Hopkins, Caldwell, Christian, McLean, Muhlenberg, and Webster counties.
- More than 2,000 Trover employees serve the healthcare needs in this region.
- Trover has more than 1,000 licensed healthcare professionals on staff and 500 registered nurses.
- 71 board certified physicians care for patients at Trover for a total of 99 physicians on the medical staff.
- Trover serves a population base of 195,000.
- Trover is accredited by The Joint Commission and has received their Gold Seal of Approval.

In 2009,

- Paid more than \$98,000,000 in annual gross wages
- Contributed more than \$21,000,000 in community benefits
- 885 babies were born at RMC
- RMC admitted 10,611 patients
- Guest Services assisted 42,511 guests
- The Emergency Department treated 32,274 patients
- The average wait time in the Emergency Department was 28 minutes, well below the national average
- 7,017 surgery procedures were performed at RMC
- Trover Clinic had 368,047 patient visits at its nine locations
- The Merle M. Mahr Cancer Center had more than 19,000 patient visits and performed 35,000 cancer treatments
- 47,239 outpatient rehabilitation services were performed
- The Food and Nutrition Department served 132,633 patient meals, averaging 5,000 catered meals per month
- Café 900 served 29,000 meals per month
- During the 2009 ice storm, Trover provided 6,000 meals to the public
- RMC volunteers averaged nearly 15,000 hours in volunteer service
